Para expresar las cosas que nos gustan y no nos gustan, usamos las más conocidas que son **like / hate** , pero tenemos muchas más que podemos utilizar cuando queremos hablar en inglés , a continuación veremos algunos ejemplos:

Observa el listado y su equivalente en español mediante dibujos si no entiendes alguna palabra usa un diccionario o traductor.

Expresiones positivas	Expresiones negativas
like 	Don't like / Doesn't like 
Love 	Hate 
Crazy about it 	Can't stand 

Cada vez que expresamos usando estas palabras o frases a nuestro verbo debemos agregar **“ing”**

Ejemplo:

I love cook**ing** = me gusta cocinar

I hate danc**ing** = odio bailar

Siempre a los **verbos** que siguen les agregaremos **ing** , pero a las otras palabras no.

Ejemplo: I love cats - I hate Mondays.

Cuando tenemos los pronombres (**she** , **he** , **it**) a la palabra le agregamos la letra **s** , observa :

She loves**s** dancing = a ella le encanta bailar

He hates**s** Winter = el odia el invierno

Para utilizar el “no le gusta “en (**she** , **he** , **it**) diremos “ **doesn't like**”

Ejemplo:

She doesn't like running = a ella no le gusta correr

He doesn't like cooking = a el no le gusta cocinar.

En las frases “crazy about it “ y “ can't stand “ no hay modificación quedan tal cual.

I**m** crazy about driving cars = me enloquece conducir autos

She **is** crazy about driving cars = a ella le enloquece conducir autos.

Lo único que acá le anteponeamos (**am, is, are**) antes de la frase.
